### **2019 Licence Forms**

Licence application forms are still available to download from the Skegness Raceway Website <http://skegness-raceway.info/Drivers/Licence%20Forms>.

To make sure you get your licence for the start of the 2019 season, the completed forms, including 2 passport photos and fee must be sent to the address on the last page of the licence form.

Please do not send your completed forms to Skegness Raceway.

### **New Drivers to Junior Formulas**

If you are licensing a child for a junior formula, Rods, Bangers or Ministox, please remember that if they haven't held a Skegness Raceway licence, they will need to complete an ORCi test. This must be booked in advance through the Skegness Raceway office, this test can be done in advance on Practice day, or prior to the start of the meeting on race day. If you are booking your test for practice day, these start at 9.15am.

Junior Rods only, for all new Junior Rod drivers, your car must pass a technical inspection before you can sit the test/race.

### **Double Decker Bangers, Caravan Bangers, Mrs & Mrs Bangers and similar**

These are classed as entertainment features and are limited on car numbers, and require booking (booking in doesn't guarantee a place).

Drivers will be selected for these events

### **Practice Day**

Sunday 24th February 2019

Always a popular date at Skegness Raceway, a chance to blow the cobwebs off you and your car and get to see some of your racing friends again. A perfect chance to set your car up & show off your brand new winter builds.

Gate opens at 9am.

Practice takes place from 10-30am until 4pm, with Marshalls, Scrutineers, First Aid all in attendance.

Practice is open to all formulas please bring your ORCi log book with you or you can fill in a day licence on the day. It is £30 for car & driver with everyone else £3-00 admission (under 12yrs as usual no charge).

For Skegness Raceway Drivers, if you have not already sent for your log book, please take a filled in form + photos along to the track so your log book can be processed ready for you to pick up at your first race meeting.

If you would like to book a new build inspection, this will need to be booked as well.**

## Internet Abuse

Please note anything put on Face book or other social media by a driver or someone associated with a driver can be subject to disciplinary action.

## Bridge Stairs

Reminder to all, please do not stand or sit on the stairs to the bridge near race control, the stairs must be clear at all times.

## Drivers Log Books

Drivers, it is important that you remember to sign your log book as soon as you receive it

## Pit area

The pit area (including the camping area) is not a test track, so its 5mph everywhere! No passengers to be carried in the cars in the pits, and also you can't ride on moving trailers, flatbeds etc when in the pits. Pit Safety is a must!

Drivers need to stop pit lane racing, in particular drivers parking their car in line but not staying within their car and instead walking off. This causes all sorts of problems, and potentially quite serious especially when it's near the ambulance area.

## Signing in

Because of the changes at the Raceway, signing in is now done in new pit office, (not at the pit gate). On arrival, park up and go to sign in **BEFORE** going to scrutineering. Your mechanic must go with you to get admission, you will need your log book with you for stamping. (Mechanics trotting along with your logbook at a later time will not gain admission). The only entrance from the pits to the stadium arena for pedestrians is via the new gateway or at the turnstiles. Only towing vehicles with race cars for the event that day are allowed into the pits. Drivers, when going to sign in, please don't drive to the Pit office, and leave you car in the walk way, please walk .And also transporters can't park in the area next to the old building on either side close to the pits office, thanks

## Alcohol

**All drivers are reminded that drinking alcohol before & during a race meeting is not allowed.**

If you are involved in an accident on track, the authorities may well breathalyse you, and there maybe consequences. Also if you have to be seen by the First Aid & go to hospital, there is a chance that you cannot receive treatment .We do have breathalysers at the stadium, and as per the rule book, any driver can be tested through the meeting.

## Fuel Caps

After an issue with a fuel cap coming astray during the course of the race, and this was with a National formula, not domestic, with this formula, the drivers mark their fuel caps with their race number, helping officials deal with the issue of a car with no fuel cap far easier. So can we suggest that drivers of our domestic formulas follow suit, and write your race number on your fuel cap, as it is as much benefit to yourselves and fellow drivers as it is to the track staff. This is not compulsory, but is advisory.



## **Booking in to Race**

Thank you to all the drivers that take the time to book in to race, as by booking in to race, it enables us to give out accurate booking lists for the public, and also enables us to plan the race formats for the meeting. It is especially important to book in for Championship meetings to enable us to finalise grids etc. We know that is not always possible, but if you do intend on racing, but unsure on whether you are able to due to work etc, then you can always book in on a provisional booking, so we know that you are intending on racing if circumstances enable you to, and then you can confirm or withdraw the booking nearer to the date of the meeting. Just as it is important to book in, it is equally important to cancel a booking if you have already booked in to race, and for whatever reason you can no longer honour that booking. It would be nice to think that we could get to 100% bookings.
