**All drivers are reminded that drinking alcohol before & during a race meeting is not allowed.** If you are involved in an accident on track, the authorities may well breathalyse you, and there may be consequences. Also if you have to be seen by the First Aid & go to hospital, there is a chance that you cannot receive treatment.

All of our domestic formulas are racing over the weekend of 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> May. We expect lots of cars so please book in (& cancel) as soon as possible.

All Drivers please remember to book in as soon as you know you are racing, and it's equally important to cancel if you know you can't make it.

### **UK Championship Speedweekend**

Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> June & Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June is the UK Championship weekend for all of our Domestic formulas.

All races on Saturday for 1300 Saloons, Rookie Bangers, Gt Hot Rods are qualifying rounds for UK Championships, to determine grid positions for the Championship races, which are the first races scheduled for Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June.

UK Championship for the MD Hot Rods & Junior Rods are the last races for your formulas on Sunday lined up in points order from the races over the two days, Lady Rookies the UK Champion is the highest point's scorer over the two days.

**Racing starts prompt at 4-30pm on Saturday and Sunday at 12 noon. Pit gates open at 1pm on Saturday it's really important you do not arrive before that time.** You can stay overnight at the Stadium, Driver is no charge, but everyone else is £20 per unit..

As there are lots of races, we need to sort the race format out; Drivers wanting to race should book in ASAP Text 07798868947 or email [hazel@skegness-stadium.info](mailto:hazel@skegness-stadium.info) or Tel 08445591228. As well as booking in it's as important to cancel your booking if you are not able to attend, again on any of the above numbers.

**On Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June, remember to sign in at the pit gate to get your log book date stamped BEFORE you go to scrutineering.**

We are always looking for people to help at the stadium on race days in all departments. If you would like to be involved with a hardworking, friendly, under paid team of racing enthusiasts than this is for you. If you feel you have the skills than please ring 0844 559 1228 for details. We particularly need someone to train as a lap scorer & timekeeper, (working the lap top), training will be given and you get to see the racing in the dry!!!

## **Please note the new rule for 2016**

During a race, you must not exit your car whilst on track or on the infield. The only exception to this is when you are in extreme danger within the car, for example in the case of fire. In this case you must exit the car with extreme care, always remembering that there is a danger of other competitors on track. You should then make your way to the nearest Safe Area. These designated 'Safe Areas' will be identified at the driver's pre meeting briefing or written Drivers Instructions.

When you remain in your car on the track, keep your harness and helmet on, until the end of the race or until the race is cautioned or stopped. You should then make your way to a designated Safe Area as noted above

### ***What should I do if I need to stop my car because of mechanical failure during a race?***

Retire to the Infield as soon and as safely as possible. When you have retired to the infield, remain in your car, keeping your harness and helmet on. You must not get out of your car even under yellow or red flag stoppages, just remain in your car, until the end of the race.

### **ORCi 2016 Rules of Racing – Dated 5th February 2016**

#### **Scrutineers**

Checks on cars will be ongoing all season, you may be asked to draw a golf ball out as you leave the track, depending on what colour you pull, you may be required to go to scrutineering bay, to have some checks done.

#### **Clerk of Course**

Drivers are reminded that when they come onto track they must go straight to their starting grid positions, do not ride round & round the track.

#### **Caravans**

The next caravan race of 2016 is on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> July 1pm, Carnival Day we do have some spaces left as two of our regular drivers are away. Remember it has to be cars that are allowed in Rookie Bangers only. We have some caravans so if you wish to take part please ring & book in or if you bring your own caravan we pay £30.

## Transponders

*Cars are required to have a Transponder fitted for lap scoring purposes for the start of 2017 Season, these will be the AMB/MyLaps Transponders and the model types can be 260DP, 260, 160DP, 160, the "DP" refers to it being a Direct Powered one, i.e. no internal rechargeable battery, the cheapest type that is compatible with the MyLaps System is the 160, as this is aimed at Karting it will work perfectly fine [stoxkarts and national mini's use them].*

## GT Hot Rods UK Championship

The UK Championship takes place over the weekend of 4<sup>th</sup>& 5<sup>th</sup> June at Skegness Stadium.

On the Saturday night, all drivers will race in three qualifying heats scoring UK Championship qualifying points. There will be a total of four or five heats on the night depending on exact car numbers. The top drivers from the qualifying process will be taken straight through to the UK Championship race on Sunday, although the exact number of guaranteed qualifiers will once again depend on how many cars are racing over the weekend.

On Sunday, the first race of the day will be a last chance qualifier which will be lined up in points order from the Saturday night with the highest scoring non-qualifier on pole position. Any driver only able to race on the Sunday will be eligible to start at the back of this race and qualify for the UK Championship if they score a high enough finishing position. The required number of places will be taken from this race to complete the UK Championship Grid which we anticipate to be a 24 car race. If any of the qualified drivers are unable to start the UK Championship race, reserves will be taken by continuing down the result of the last chance race.

After the championship race, further events will be run on the Sunday (once again, the exact format to be determined by the number of available cars) to ensure that drivers have the opportunity to enter a minimum of three races on the day.
