Welcome to the start of the 2016 Race Season, all of the dates for the coming year are enclosed, please keep a note of the booking in procedure.

We are always looking for people to help at the stadium on race days in all departments. If you would like to be involved with a hardworking, friendly, underpaid team of racing enthusiasts than this is for you. If you feel you have the skills than please ring 0844 559 1228 for details. We particularly need someone to train as a lap scorer & timekeeper, (working the lap top), training will be given and you get to see the racing in the dry!!!

Please note the new rule for 2016 - ORCi 2016 Rules of Racing – Dated 5th February 2016

During a race, you must not exit your car whilst on track or on the infield.

The only exception to this is when you are in extreme danger within the car, for example in the case of fire. In this case you must exit the car with extreme care, always remembering that there is a danger of other competitors on track. You should then make your way to the nearest Safe Area. These designated 'Safe Areas' will be identified at the driver's pre meeting briefing or written Drivers Instructions.

When you remain in your car on the track, keep your harness and helmet on, until the end of the race or until the race is cautioned or stopped. You should then make your way to a designated Safe Area as noted above.

What should I do if I need to stop my car because of mechanical failure during a race?

Retire to the Infield as soon and as safely as possible. When you have retired to the infield, remain in your car, keeping your harness and helmet on. You must not get out of your car even under yellow or red flag stoppages, just remain in your car, until the end of the race.

Scrutineers

Checks on cars will be ongoing all season, you may be asked to draw a golf ball out as you leave the track, depending on what color you pull, you may be required to go to scrutineering bay, to have some checks done.

Fuel

The only fuel allowed is pump fuel up to 99ron, no additives. Fuel tests will be ongoing all season.

Clerk of Course

Drivers are reminded that when they come onto track they must go straight to their starting grid positions, do not ride round & round the track.

Rules 2016

In line with other promotions Ford Focus will not be allowed in Rookie Bangers from 2016.

But for those that have them in stock Focus can be used in the BBA and Crashattack meetings.

We will be continuing with stringent check on engines in the Rookies and remember bans can & will be issued for irregularities.

We have re-introduced the buying car policy, where the Promotion can buy a Rookie Banger (less safety equipment, Manifold, Carb.) for £200. If a Driver refuses then the same rule applies where if a part is not left for checking, the Driver is deemed to be illegal and will be subject to a BOC.

Head

Head may be skimmed to a minimum of **94**.

Tyres,

The only tyres permitted are 175/70R 13 82P Kingpin Pacer (highway pattern) and 175/70R13 82T, Yokohama Bluearth AE-01, 175/70R13 82T Kumho Solus KH17

Transponders

Cars are required to have a Transponder fitted for lap scoring purposes for the start of 2017 Season, these will be the AMB/MyLaps Transponders and the model types can be 260DP, 260, 160DP, 160, the "DP" refers to it being a Direct Powered one, i.e. no internal rechargeable battery, the cheapest type that is compatible with the MyLaps System is the 160, as this is aimed at Karting it will work perfectly fine [stoxkarts and national mini's use them.

Carbs

A secondary fixing **MUST** be used on the fuel feed inlet pipe connection to the carburettor. The secondary fixing **MUST** be completely independent of the primary fixing for the fuel feed inlet pipe.

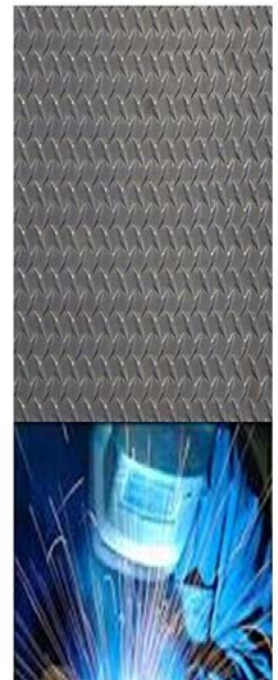

Cars will be weighed in the forthcoming season to determine an average weight. All four wheels must have brakes and working. Cutting down of shoe pads is not allowed.

Engines

Standard Ford ECU or EDIS to be used, Megajolt and similar ignition modules are not permitted.

Suspension

Tethering chains are not allowed.
