Caravan Race_

The next Caravan race is on Sunday 6th November, the only cars allowed are the same cars currently being used in Rookie Bangers. We have some Caravans if you wish to use one.

Again please ring 0844 559 1228 as soon as possible to book your caravan.

New Cars - All new build cars for 1300 Saloons, GT Hot Rods, MD Hot Rods, Junior Rods need to be pre – scrutineered. In most cases the Scrutineers will not do it prior to the meeting you want to race at as, changes may have to be made. To go towards the cost of Scrutineers travelling distances, and them giving up their work & leisure time there is a £25 fee. The payment of this must be arranged through the office.

All drivers are reminded that drinking alcohol before & during a race meeting is not allowed.
If you are involved in an accident on track, the authorities may well breathalyze you, and there maybe consequences. Also if you have to be seen by the First Aid & go to hospital, there is a chance that you cannot receive treatment.

All Drivers please remember to book in as soon as you know you are racing, and it's equally important to cancel if you know you can't make it.

Scrutineer's checks on cars will be ongoing all season. You may be asked to draw a golf ball out as you leave the track, depending on what colour you pull, you may be required to go to scrutineering bay, to have some checks done.

Rookie Bangers reminder

Team racing is not allowed, and if you continue with it the driver you are helping may well have their places removed from the results.

STRUT BRACE - ROOKIE BANGERS

With immediate effect drivers are now permitted to fit a strut brace to their rookie bangers. This brace connects the leg tops, must be made using a maximum of 1 and a half inch box or tubing 3mm thickness and must be bolted NOT WELDED to the leg tops. The brace must be free and NOT have any other brackets/attachments/connections, and MUST NOT be attached to any other part of the car or engine.

This strut brace is purely for the purpose of holding the legs up to help prevent camber and for no other reason!!

We will be continuing with stringent check on engines in the Rookies and remember bans can & will be issued for irregularities.

We have re-introduced the buying car policy, where the Promotion can buy a Rookie Banger (less safety equipment, Manifold, Carb.) for £200. If a Driver refuses then the same rule applies where if a part is not left for checking, the Driver is deemed to be illegal and will be subject to a BOC.

The annual Rookie Bangers under 25yrs Championship race will be on Sunday 6thNovember, the race is eligible to any Rookie Driver aged 25yrs & under up to & including 6thNovember, current list of Drivers; The Annual Award is sponsored by Tony Cooke from TCM racing.

A special message to the parents, guardians, car builders of Junior Rods, you need to make sure that your car is to spec. Suspension must be standard.

There will be checks at the Gold Roof meeting, before, during and after racing. None of the officials want to see Drivers, especially kids taken out of the results, but it is your kids that will suffer if the cars are not to spec.

Sponsor for the Junior Rod Gold Roof race. JCS Garage will present 2 x tyres to the winner, 1 x tyre to 2nd & 3rd. place.

A parent or guardian must accompany a Junior Driver when they go to scrutineering, remember to take your safety gear with you.

Drivers are reminded that under ORCi rules you are not allowed to race the same car at a non ORCi circuit, and then race it at an ORCi circuit.

Parents & those that accompany Junior Rods are reminded that we operate a zero tolerance with this formula, incidents of intimidation, verbal & physical abuse will be reported to the BOC and may well result in your Driver being banned from racing. If there are any further incidents the Mothers of the kids will be removed from the Stadium Arena whilst Junior Rod racing is on.
